1. **Purpose.** This action letter supersedes NSCC Action Letter 7-93.
2. **Discussion.** Per reference (a), the Navy Education and Training Program Management Support Activity (NETPMSA) has agreed to continue to provide logistical and administrative support for Navy correspondence courses submitted by NSCC cadets. Providing the procedures outlined in enclosure (1) are followed, NETPMSA will ensure that orders for courses are properly filled; answer sheets are graded; and cadets receive credit for courses completed.
3. **Action.**
 - a. Unit commanding officers should assign a Correspondence Course Control Officer.
 - b. The Correspondence Course Control Officer should:
 - (1) Order NAVEDTRA 1510/1 forms (sample form shown in enclosure (2)) from the address provided in enclosure (1). You must order and send an original form. Copies of the form will not be processed. Read instructions contained in enclosure (1) closely.
 - (2) Complete and submit the correspondence course order forms and maintain a log to accurately account for all courses ordered.

Subj: **CORRESPONDENCE COURSE SUPPORT FOR NAVAL SEA CADET CORPS**

(3) Monitor progress of each cadet with correspondence courses and ensure timely submission of answer sheets (at least one per month per cadet) to NETPMSA. Cadets failing to submit an answer sheet within eight months after enrollment, will be automatically disenrolled from the course

(4) Order only those courses listed in enclosure (3).

4. **Cancellation.** This action letter is cancelled upon inclusion in the NSCC/NLCC Advancement and Training Manual.

CORRESPONDENCE COURSE PROGRAM FOR NSCC PERSONNEL

All correspondence courses for Naval Sea Cadet Corps (NSCC) personnel are administered and graded through Naval Education and Training Program Management Support Activity (NETPMSA), Pensacola (Code 036). Course procedures are as follows:

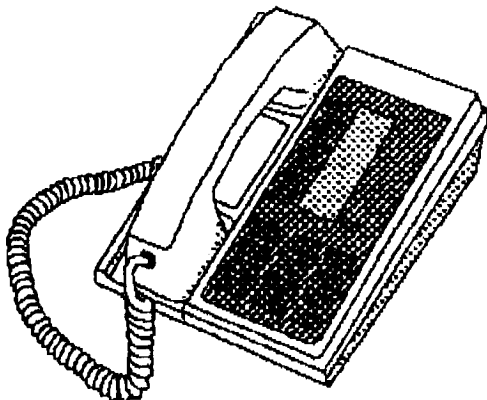
- Applicant completes Correspondence Course Enrollment Application/Change Request (NAVEDTRA 1510/1) form and returns it to NETPMSA. Students may enroll in three courses at a time. Computer processing prohibits the use of photo copies of enrollment forms and will reject course enrollment in more than 3 courses at a time. When requested, NETPMSA provides Units with an updated course list and a list of the courses that are currently out of stock.
- NETPMSA processes enrollment form and mails course material to member if available. All course material is shipped Special Fourth Class Rate. Expect a 2-6 week delay to receive course material.
- Member completes course and returns Correspondence Course Standard Answer Sheet, NAVEDTRA 1510/4 to NETPMSA for grading. The student is responsible for completing one assignment per month per course. Photo copies of answer sheets (NAVEDTRA 1510/4) will not be processed since all answer sheets are computer graded.
- NETPMSA grades answer sheets and provides completion certificate to member.

SPECIAL NOTE

NAVEDTRA FORMS - Computer processing prohibits the use of photo copies of enrollment forms and answer sheets. Using any form other than original Correspondence Course Enrollment Application/Change Request, NAVEDTRA 1510/1 (12-90) and Correspondence Course Standard Answer Sheet, NAVEDTRA 1510/4 (03-94) will result in delays, errors, and other problems. Enrollment forms (NAVEDTRA 1510/1) are available **ONLY** from NETPMSA. Request for enrollment applications should be submitted to NETPMSA on Unit letterhead.
