Subj: OpSail 2000 Ribbon Award

1. National Chairman Bruce B. Smith has authorized the re-issue of the International Naval Review (INR) ribbon award for those officers, midshipmen, instructors, and NSCC/NLCC cadets who participated in the OpSail 2000 Celebration during the period 25 May – 31 July 2000.


The INR Ribbon will now be the **INR/OpSail 2000 Ribbon**. The ribbon is red, white and blue; the colors equally divided vertically across and will be worn with the blue side inboard. For NLCC cadets, the ribbon takes precedence immediately after the NSCC/NLCC Marksman Ribbon.

For NSCC officers, midshipmen, instructors and NSCC cadets the ribbon takes precedence immediately after the NLCC Service Ribbon (if earned). Eligibility to wear the ribbon is to be noted in the individuals' service record. All those who previously earned the INR ribbon may affix a large (5/16') Silver Star to the Ribbon.

2. Officers, Instructors and midshipmen participating in the OpSail 2000 as escort officers, and who are authorized to wear the ribbon, may also wear the NSCC Escort Officer Ribbon.

3. The INR/OpSail 2000 Ribbon is available from Dondero after approval of letter of request to NSCC NHQ.

4. **Cancellation.** This letter is cancelled when incorporated into NSCC Awards manual.
