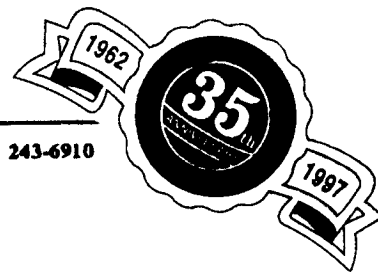



Subj: Change in Deputy Director, Naval Sea Cadet Corps and New Assignment as NSCC Field Representative, Southeast Region; Regions 5, 6, and 10.

1. **Purpose.** To advise all units and field staff of NSCC Head Quarters and Field Representative personnel changes.
2. **Background.** The Southeast Region NSCC Field Representative position having cognizance over regions 5, 6, and 10 has until recently been filled by Capt Hugh Carroll. In February of this year Capt Carroll vacated that position after 4 years of outstanding and dedicated service to the NSCC. Capt Carroll has relocated to Florida, and we wish him well in all his new endeavors.
3. **Discussion.** Effective 1 April 1998, Capt Ron Baker who until that date served as NSCC HQ Deputy Director, will assume duties as the newly assigned NSCC Field Representative for the Southeast Region. Capt Henry J. Nyland will assume duties as the Deputy Director 1 April. Capt Nyland joins the NSCC HQ staff after completing a full career as a TAR officer. His most recent assignment was Deputy Commander, Naval Reserve Readiness Command Region Six in Washington, D.C. His prior assignments include duty with Washington, D.C. area senior echelon staffs including OPNAV, BUPERS, and NAVSEASYSKOM. He has had command of Naval and Marine Corps Reserve Centers in Greensboro, N.C., Lubbock, Tx., and Amarillo, Tx. and served on Naval Reserve Readiness Command staffs in Scotia, N.Y. and Great Lakes, Ill. Operational/fleet assignments include U.S.S. New Orleans LPH 11, Commander Amphibious Group Four, and assignment as a Naval Advisor to Coastal Group 15, RVN.
