

Dear Student:

Enclosed is the Navy League scholarship application form that you recently requested. Only one application form is needed to apply for all of the scholarships offered through the Navy League of the United States.

Please read this letter and the application form very carefully. Failure to fill out the forms completely and in the proper order will result in having your application disqualified.

The Navy League annually awards eight scholarships worth \$2,500 each. These are one-time scholarships. Award winners need to re-apply each year to be reconsidered for further scholarship funds.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The student must...

- * Be a direct dependent of current, former or retired sea service personnel (including deceased personnel) of the Navy, Marine Corps, U.S. Coast Guard, or U.S. Merchant Marines. (A direct dependent means that the person in the sea service claimed you, or could have claimed you as an exemption on their most recent income tax form.)
- * Be a citizen of the United States.
- * Be a high school graduate, (or equivalent) or must be graduating from high school by the end of the 1998/99 school year.
- * Be entering their freshman year in college.
- * Be under the age of 25.
- * Have at least a 3.0 grade point average (B average) on a 4.0 grade scale.
- * Demonstrate financial need.
- * Preference for scholarships will be given to students who plan to continue their education in mathematics and/or the sciences.

All application information must be submitted at the same time. Please note that several schools will not permit the student to send his or her own transcript information. If this is the case, the student will need to submit his or her supporting documentation to the school and the school will have to submit the entire application to the Navy League. Partial applications will not be accepted for any reason.

DEAD LINE:

All applications must be received by the Scholarship Coordinator at the Navy League of the U.S., 2300 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, VA 22201, no later than April 1, 1999. Applications received after the April 1st deadline (for any reason) will not be considered. No applications will be mailed out, faxed, or picked up after March 16, 1999.

NOTIFICATION:

Award winners will be notified by May 17, 1999. Only scholarship recipients will be notified. You will not be notified if you do not receive a scholarship.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- * A typed statement of personal goals and career objectives in 200 words or less. (Handwritten statements will not be accepted.)
- * Parent's most recent Federal Income Tax Return. (Form 1040, 1040A or 1040 EZ.) If you filed your income taxes independently, and were not claimed on another income tax form last year, please submit your own tax returns for consideration. You do NOT need to include all of the supporting IRS income tax form documents. Only include a photocopy of the completed 1040, 1040 A or 1040 EZ form itself.
- * Your high school transcript. Include a photocopy of your official SAT or ACT score if it does not appear on your high school transcript.
- * Proof of sea service duty. A photocopy of discharge papers or a current military ID card from the sea service member in which you are a dependant.
- * You may include up to 2 letters of recommendation. Only 2 letters will be accepted with the application, all others will be discarded. All recommendations must be typed.
- * If you feel that you have extenuating circumstances that might affect the consideration of your application, please include the details of your situation on a single sheet of paper. Please type all explanations. No handwritten letters will be accepted. (Not required with application.)

HELPFUL HINTS:

- * Submit the entire application at the same time.
- * When submitting your application, put the documents in this order...
 1. Application form (Typed or printed neatly with a pen. Only the application form may be printed)
 2. Your *typed* statement of personal goals & career objectives (200 words or less.)
 3. Income Tax Form (Remember, no supporting income tax documentation is required.)
 4. Your high school transcript with ACT and/or SAT scores.
 5. Proof of sea service duty.
 6. Letters of recommendation. (Limit 2)
 7. Extenuating circumstances sheet. (Not required with application. Limit, 1 typed page.)
- * Do not staple any part of your application together.
- * Affix application together with a large paper clip in the upper left hand corner of the application.
- * Do not put your application in a folder or cover sheet of any kind.
- * Do not send art work, award certificates, etc. with your application.
- * Check your spelling & grammar. A neat presentation counts.

Preference will be given to students who's parents served at the U.S. Naval facility, Philippines, Subic Bay, Cubi Point, or San Miguel between 1980 & 1992.
- * Submit the entire application at the same time. Partial applications will not be accepted.
- * When submitting your application, put the documents in this order...
