BELGIUM

1. **Dates**. Arrive Brussels 9 July, depart 25 July.
2. **General**. This to be a Belgium Sea Cadet exchange with SHAPE/NATO training.
3. **Training/Activities**. Arrive daytime 9 July. 10 and 11 July with host families, 12 July in Summer Whites at SHAPE and sight seeing MONS, 13 July in Summer Whites at SHAPE and sight seeing a chateau, 14 & 15 sightseeing Waterloo and 2 castles, 16 possible trip to Zeebrugge, 17 & 18 weekend with Belgium Sea Cadets, 19 & 20 in Summer Whites for a NATO visit and sight seeing Brussels, 21 in Dress Whites for trip to Eupen and Belgian National Day, WWII cemetery, Bastagone, Battle of the Bulge Memorial, Luxembourg, 22 & 23 still open, 24 SACEUR, SHAPE, graduation ceremonies and farewell picnic. NSCC LCDR's Ann and Hans Greene (he's active duty Navy stationed in Belgium) will greet and escort arriving cadets and any other escorts for this exchange. A stateside adult to assist in administrative preparation and to also go on this exchange would be most welcome. **Call Capt Nyland.**
4. **Qualifications**.
 - Absolutely impeccable manners and the utmost of respect for others*, cadets will be hosted by host nation families for a portion of their visit.
 - 16 years of age or older
 - E-3 or above
 - Awarded the NSCC Cadet Citation Ribbon
 - Recommended by Unit Commanding Officer
 - Preference to cadets having knowledge of French or German (but not required)
5. **Logistics/Costs**. Cadets will be responsible for air travel to and from Brussels, Belgium. Cost will be somewhere around \$300.00 excluding to and from transportation. Summer and Dress white uniforms will be required as per the above tentative schedule. Neat and comfortable civilian dress for other activities. Leave baggy and/or faddish dress at home. \$75.00 of the \$300.00 to go to host families for food, lodging expenses, etc.
6. **Application Procedures**. **SUBMIT NSC-22 APPLICATION WITH CO LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION DIRECTLY TO NHQ, DO NOT SEND TO COTC. BE PREPARED TO PAY COTC/SENIOR ESCORT OFFICER AMOUNTS DUE FOR HOST FAMILY REIMBURSEMENT UPON REPORTING.** Applications for this exchange must be received at NHQ not later than 18 June. Priority to those submitting early until quotas gone.

8. **Other**. **PASSPORTS REQUIRED.** Quota is 10 cadets and 1 escort.
