RMKS/1. PURPOSE OF THIS MSG IS TO SOLICIT SUPPORT FOR NAVAL SEA CADET  
CORPS (NSCC) PROGRAM.  
2. NSCC IS SPONSORED BY THE NAVY LEAGUE AND IS A FEDERALLY CHARTERED,  
NON-PROFIT YOUTH ORGANIZATION WHOSE CHARTER IS TO ACQUAINT HIGH SCHOOL  
AGE YOUTHS (13-17) WITH THE NAVY AND GUIDE THEIR INTEREST IN MILITARY  
SERVICE. NEARLY 400 YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN FROM NSCC ENTER THE SEA  
SERVICES EACH YEAR IN EITHER AN ENLISTED OR OFFICER PROGRAM. THESE  
CADETS PROVIDE THE NAVY WITH AN ACCESSION SOURCE OF CAREER-MINDED,  
WELL-DISCIPLINED, AND HIGHLY MOTIVATED INDIVIDUALS.  
3. NSCC PROVIDES A VALUABLE TRAINING GROUND FOR POTENTIAL NAVAL  
OFFICERS AND ENLISTED PERSONNEL. PARTICIPATION IN NSCC AS A VOLUNTEER  
ADULT LEADER OR ADOPTION OF A SEA CADET UNIT ARE EXCELLENT MEANS TO  
IMPROVE ACCESSIONS.  
4. REF A PROVIDES GUIDANCE CONCERNING COMMAND ASSISTANCE TO THE NAVAL  
SEA CT CORPS. NSCC NEEDS QUALIFIED, VOLUNTEER ADULT LEADERS AS WELL AS  
TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES ON OPERATIONAL UNITS AND SHORE  
FACILITIES. COMMANDING OFFICERS AND OFFICERS IN CHARGE SHOULD ENSURE  
THAT POTENTIAL VOLUNTEERS ARE AWARE OF THE GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION  
IN NSCC. COMMANDS ARE ENCOURAGED TO LOOK FOR OPPORTUNITIES TO PROVIDE  
TRAINING TO SEA CADETS THAT DO NOT INTERFERE WITH OPERATIONAL  
COMMITMENTS OR SHORE SUPPORT TO DEPLOYED UNITS.
