Subj: POLICY AND RESPONSIBILITIES CONCERNING NAVAL SEA  
CADET CORPS (NSCC)

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5760.2C  
(b) OPNAVINST 5760.5B  
(c) MANMED

1. Purpose. To implement references (a) and (b), and establish policy and responsibilities in support of the NSCC Program amongst Naval Reserve Force activities.
2. Cancellation. COMNAVRESFORINST 5760.2A
3. Background. The NSCC was established by the Navy League of the United States in 1958 at the request of the Department of the Navy, as a volunteer, nonprofit training organization for young people ages 14 through 17. Commander, Naval Reserve Force has designated Commander, Naval Reserve Recruiting Command to perform duties of NSCC coordination and administration.
4. Objectives. The Navy supports the NSCC as part of its overall effort to create a favorable image in the minds of American youth.
5. Policy. Reference (a) provides the Department of Navy's policy to support Navy youth programs to the maximum extent possible within the limits of available resources; and to the extent that this participation will not interfere with assigned military missions. Navy youth programs are to afford equal opportunity for participation to all American youths without regard for race, color, sex, creed, or national origin.
6. Support. Addressees will cooperate with local Navy League councils, their Sea Cadet Committees and Regional Directors of the NSCC in their efforts to establish and maintain the NSCC Program. This cooperation is to include the following:
  - a. Publicize and encourage participation in the NSCC training program by active and inactive duty personnel. Qualifications, benefits, and training of the NSCC are described in reference (b).

b. Issue nonpay orders as appropriate to Naval Reservists participating in approved NSCC Programs.

c. Ensure that participating service member volunteers have appropriate comments included in their fitness reports and performance evaluations. For dual-affiliates, a concurrent fitness report would be in order. Letters of recognition for enlisted members are encouraged.

d. Allow the use of Naval Reserve Force berthing facilities on a space available basis by personnel of the NSCC for the purpose of drilling. Facility use shall not interfere with the primary mission or cause undue interference with normal activities.

e. Render medical care per reference (c) on a temporary (emergency) basis until disposition can be effected for members of the NSCC who are injured or become ill while participating in Navy or Marine Corps sponsored sports, recreational, or training activities.

f. Naval Reserve Force units with medical officers attached and Naval Reserve Force activities with active duty medical officers will provide medical examinations for NSCC applicants on a not-to-interfere basis. The results of the examination will be recorded on the Report of Medical History (NSC-5A) and Report of Medical Examination (NSC-5B) and provided to NSCC commanding officers for filing in the cadet's service jacket. Medical personnel will also examine and certify cadet's physical fitness to participate in 2 week training periods per chapter 15 of reference (c).

g. Per reference (b), commanding officers of Naval Reserve Force activities are to assist, as requested, in coordination of orientation flights and daylight/overnight cruises for cadets.

h. Assist NSCC leaders in obtaining appropriate excess and surplus uniforms.

i. Provide messing as available to NSCC personnel.

7. Action. Addressees are directed to implement the provision of this instruction as applicable. The following administrative procedures shall be followed:

a. Commanders/commanding officers of Naval Reserve Readiness Commands/Naval Air Stations/Naval Air Reserve Centers/Naval Reserve Centers/Naval Air Facilities will designate an active duty officer at their activity as NSCC liaison officer within their command.

- b. Monitor and inspect, as requested, NSCC unit training.
  - c. Medical forms shall be stocked by the local Naval Reserve activity.
8. Forms. NSC-5A, Report of Medical History, and NSC-5B, Report of Medical Examination, may be obtained from Naval Sea Cadet National Headquarters, 2300 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, VA 22201.
