### **National Headquarters**

Goal: Achieve National NSCC Strength of 12,000 including at least 10,000 Sea/ League Cadets with at least one unit in every State

Goal: Continue to enforce chain of command.

Goal: Monitor Goals on a quarterly basis.

### **Headquarters Field Representatives**

Goal: Have at least one unit in each of the 50 States

Form at least one unit in States of:

Montana  
South Dakota  
Vermont  
Wyoming

Goal: Attend at least one NL Council Meeting a quarter at a Council not sponsoring Sea / League Cadet Unit to encourage sponsorship / formation.

### **Regional Directors**

Goal: Achieve a Minimum of 1 Unit ( Sea and League) net growth in assigned Region

Goal: Assist Hqtrs. Field Rep. in achieving goal of Unit in every State. (if applicable).

### **Commanding Officers**

Goal: Increase Unit net strength (Minimum 20%)

Goal: Increase cadet attendance at summer training. Have 5 % or less of unit cadets who do not attend summer training.
